Old Windows Pose MANY Risks to the Structural Integrity of the Home

For example, excess humidity could soften wood in your walls or your floors.

- 4. While we are on the topic of walls and floors, let's take a moment to discuss those components of your home. If windows are improperly seated or are not functioning properly, any excess moisture that makes its way into the home could negatively impact the building materials used to construct your home. Do you think you could afford to replace a wall or a floor? Most people find these expenses undue burdens!
- 5. Finally, if your old windows are letting in a lot of moisture, that moisture will be highly attractive to wood-destroying insects such as carpenter ants and termites. If these insects make their way into your home, they can continue damaging areas that are already vulnerable. In fact, the nesting and feeding activities of these insects can actually <u>DESTROY</u> the entire home to the point of <u>NO RETURN</u>!

Ways Windows Can Have an Impact on Your Health

Now that you know that those old windows have the potential to – literally – destroy your home, just think about what impact they could have on your **<u>HEALTH</u>**!

It is not pretty; we can tell you that!

• If windows become uneven to the point where the glass separates from the frame or starts to cracks, there is a risk that the entire pane could fall out or shatter. If this happens when you are near the window, you stand a chance of sustaining serious and even potentially life-threatening injuries.



- If lead is within the glass or surrounding frame of an old window, those exposed to the products may develop lead poisoning. Examples of symptoms experienced include joint and muscle pain, cognitive complications, stomach problems, reproductive issues, mood problems, breathing difficulties, and <u>MORE</u>!
- Moisture results in the growth of mold, mildew, algae, and fungus. ALL of these substances could result in severe health problems. Examples include breathing difficulties, gastrointestinal complications, cognitive issues, allergies, and other health effects.
- If gaps or spaces develop within an old window system, it allows access for a wide array of insects and possible pests. Naturally, infestations may result in many types of health problems to humans and pets. Examples include asthma, allergies, respiratory problems, skin irritations, gastrointestinal complications, and even serious illnesses such as Lyme disease, microbial diseases, fungal infections, and various viruses and bacterial infections.
- If moisture and humidity break down the wood surrounding old windows, it could result in the formation of wood dust. This substance poses many health risks. Examples include irritation to the eyes and nasal cavities, breathing problems, skin irritation and ulceration, dermatitis, allergies, asthma, and even the development of lung cancer.
